# BlueFloat Energy, Energy Estate and Elemental Group welcome Nathan Turner as Country Manager, New Zealand

A joint venture (JV) of BlueFloat Energy (BlueFloat), Energy Estate and Elemental Group are delighted to announce the appointment of Nathan Turner as Country Manager for the partnership based in New Zealand. In his new role Nathan will oversee the JV's plans to develop up to 5GW of offshore wind energy projects in Aotearoa.

Starting his new role in November Nathan joins the consortium from Transpower where he was Planning, Scheduling and Optimisation Manager responsible for managing major capital investment programmes to upgrade the grid and new connections. Nathan brings with him extensive international experience in the energy sector particularly in developing new strategies to enable the energy transition towards a net-zero future.

Prior to joining Transpower Nathan was the General Manager for Shell Energy New Markets in Asia. Based in Singapore, he started new energy businesses in the Philippines and Malaysia and developed Shell's power growth strategy in Asia incorporating the New Energies and Trading divisions. In this role he worked closely with Shell's New Energies team to assess opportunities in renewable power generation in Asia, including offshore wind, and their potential future integration into existing local energy systems.

Before joining Shell, Nathan held management positions at QGC, formerly part of the BG Group before being acquired by Shell in 2016. In these roles Nathan had responsibility for JV, customer and commercial relationships and interacting with government and regulators.

Nathan is a qualified commercial solicitor who spent the early part of his career with international law firm King and Wood, Mallesons based in Brisbane predominantly working on M&A transactions, asset sales, corporate governance and commercial litigation in the materials and energy sectors.

"We are delighted to have someone of Nathan's calibre on our team. He has extensive experience in the energy sector and a track record of implementing complex large-scale infrastructure investments that have required him to work closely with indigenous peoples, governments, regulators, JV partners and customers to deliver integrated, strategic energy solutions."
